Getting Started

The following steps will show you how to use install and use Race Parts Inventory Pro.


Installation

Insert the CD and the installation will begin. It is suggested that you install the program in My Documents folder. There will be a shortcut to the program placed on the Desktop and added to the Programs Menu. In the folder within the Programs Menu you will see the program, the option to uninstall, and the documentation.

Backing Up Data

Race Parts Inventory Pro creates a backup of your data every time you close the program. The data is written to **C:/Stock Car Stats Pro Sprint/Backup/backup.clz**. Be sure to periodically copy this data to a CD, USB flash drive or any other type of offline storage. If your computer ever fails, this data can be entered into a new installation of the program.

A few tips about using the program:

- 1) Clicking on a red arrow icon when you are viewing a List will take you to a screen showing more detailed information for the item you have selected.
- 2) When you are in a List view, a thin, dark line will appear on the very left of the item you have currently selected.
- 3) The gray headers across the top of the lists can be clicked on to sort the information based on the heading. All columns can be sorted either ascending or descending.

All information is typically stored immediately. There is no Save button used and there is no Undo option. No need to worry about selecting Save before leaving a screen.

Registering Software

The following steps will show you how to receive the serial number for your installation of Race Parts Inventory Pro and how to enter the program.

The first time you open Race Parts Inventory Pro, you will stop at the Register screen. You will be provided with the Registration ID for your copy of the program. Contact us to get the serial number to complete the registration of your program. You will be able to use the program for 15 days without the serial number. After that, the program will no longer run until the correct serial number is entered.

Select Go To The Main Screen to enter the program during the 15 day grace period.

Once you have the serial number, select Enter a New Code to enter the serial number. The program will acknowledge whether the serial number is correct or not. If it is correct, you will be taken to the List View. You will always go directly to the List View once the correct serial number has been entered.

List View Screen

The following steps will show you how to use the List View portion of Race Parts Inventory Pro.

The List View will show you all parts that you have on hand.

1. You can sort this information by using the headers Part/Product Name, Manufacturer, Part Number, Qty on Hand or Location.
2. Options to Add Parts, to Show All Parts and Print a List of the Parts is available in this screen.
3. There is a search option available to help find a specific part.
4. Selecting the red arrow at the beginning of the row will take you to the detail information for that specific part.
5. Selecting the red minus at the end of the row will permanently delete the item from inventory.

The following steps will show you how to use the Part Detail screen in Race Parts Inventory Pro.

The Part Detail screen will show you detailed information for the part such as the quantity, a description of the part, Manufacturer, Part Number, when it was purchased, where it was purchased, where it is located and any notes about the part.

1. Options to Add a Part or Delete this Part are available in this screen.
2. You may return to the list of parts by selecting View Parts List.
3. You may print the information specific to this part.
3. There is a search option available to help find a specific part.

The following steps will show you how to use the Search Feature of Race Parts Inventory Pro.

Selecting the Search option for the List View or the Detail View will bring you to this screen. Here you can enter information about the part you are searching for. You can enter search criteria in one field or multiple fields. The more fields you enter information in, the smaller the list of parts found. The fewer fields you enter information in, the larger the list of parts found.

1. Select Cancel to cancel the search.
2. Select Continue to complete the search and go to the list of parts found.
